

# **Bellahøj – Barking & Dagenham**

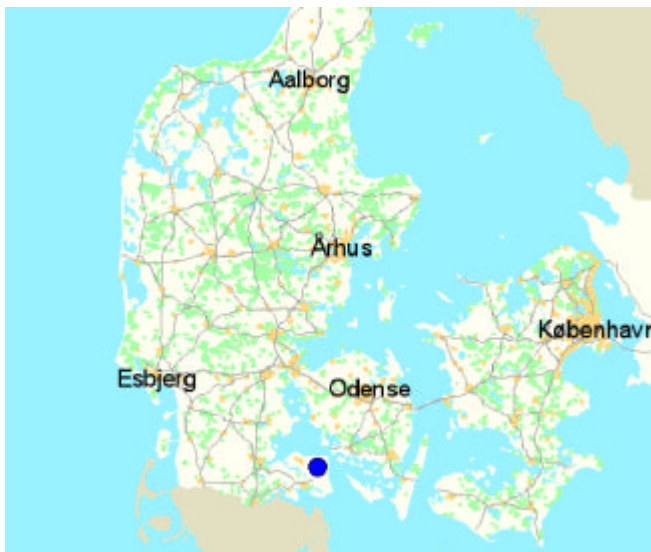
## **Summer Camp 2008**



**When:** The 2008 Exchange Summer Camp will be in Denmark, from the 26<sup>th</sup> July to the 9<sup>th</sup> August 2008. The first week will be a classical Danish Scout Camp, and the second will be a home hospitality week in Copenhagen.

**Where:** The Camp is going to be held on the campsite "Trolldhøj" on the island Als, in the southern part of Denmark.

**What to do:** The **Camp Week** at Trolldhøj, will be a traditional Danish Scout camp: We will be working in patrols, sleeping in tents, doing pioneering and cooking over real fires. The Trolldhøj campsite is situated directly at the sea. There will also be a hike, with one night outside the camp where the scouts will be sleeping in bivouacs. The night places on the hike, will be places that the leaders know beforehand. We are also trying to obtain some fresh fish we can cook or smoke, to sail in reconstructions of Viking boats and walk to the nearby city.

## **Summer Camp 2008**



**What to do:** The Home Hospitality Week will be in Bellahøj/Brønshøj in Copenhagen. During the week we will arrange some different activities: Sightseeing tour through Copenhagen, a swimming day in the harbour or at a beach, a trip to an amusement park, football match and barbecues.

**The Price:** The price for the two weeks Summer Camp in Denmark will be £70. The cost for transport to Denmark is not included in the price.

**Where to fly to:** For you it probably will be the easiest if you fly to Copenhagen (or alternatively Sturup/Malmö in Sweden). Then you can travel together with the Danish Scouts to the camp.

An alternative is that you fly to Billund in Jylland. But for the return, you will have to fly from Copenhagen!

**What to bring:** Clothes and equipment for an outdoor camp. That includes a rucksack in which you can carry your own gear and some common stuff on a hike (at least 10 km), and some good hiking shoes.

Try maybe to bring two bags, so that it will be possible to separate the stuff for the two weeks, eventually leaving that for the Home Hospitality Week back in Copenhagen at your arrival.

**When to sign up for the camp:** We would very much like if we could have the first briefing about how many you are expecting to come on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2007. The final sign up for the camp is 1<sup>st</sup> April 2008.
