

Rules

This is just an outline. A full set of rules for each section is available from the organizing team. Please make sure that you consult the full set before you compete in any events.

Identification

Each competitor must wear their Group scarf and a card. The card must be of a minimum size (8" x 5" or 21 cm x 13 cm), the card must **not** be covered in plastic. This card is to be worn on their top garment at the front, clearly showing their Group name, section letter and their own name. They should also display Track or Field to confirm their chosen events (track or field).

Use of the Arena

Only race officials, competitors and leaders are allowed in the arena.

Only those wearing a Group, Fellowship or District scarf will be allowed into the arena. Anyone in the arena must wear a scarf at all times. **This will apply to everyone, parents and leaders.**

All spectators (family, friends etc.) are to use the grandstand.

No ball games or bikes will be allowed in the arena.

All groups are to bring black rubbish bags in order to dispose of their rubbish.

All groups are to provide their own First-Aid kits.

All groups are asked to help organize, set up and run the sports day. They are also asked to help clear away and tidy the arena before leaving.

Disqualification

Any Group or individual not complying with the rules will be disqualified from the race or event in question. If you have a query or question please take it up with the organizing team in the tent. Do not question the decisions of the judges and adjudicators.

Presentations

All Scouts must be in uniform in time for the presentations at the end of the day. Please make sure that your Group stay to see **all** the presentations as this is only polite.
